This project requires you to produce a functional website for a **club of your choice**. You might choose to create a website for a school club, or for a club in the community. If you're really ambitious, you might want to create a site for a band's concert tour, or for a business (such as a juice bar, restaurant).

This site will be live online, so you must make sure that you don't post photos of yourself or friends, or include personal information about yourself.

1. Your website will comprise
 - a. **Home Page**

b. Minimum of 5 linking pages
