Step 4 – Create an ending credits slide. It should say the following toys were showcased in this film... (list the toys you included)



# Saving as a Movie File



Make sure students save as Movie File once they are finished and will not be making any more changes. (Note: saving in this format does not allow changes to be made)

Go to File – Save as Movie File

This will save as media player so that it can be viewed properly from any computer. **Media player is a term typically used to describe computer software for playing back multimedia files.**

If you have students hand-in their movies without saving this way, I have found that often times the pictures will not show up.
