## Background

  2. **Create the trailer in Movie Maker**



# Download and Unzip the Resources

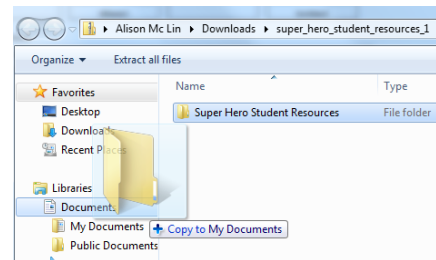
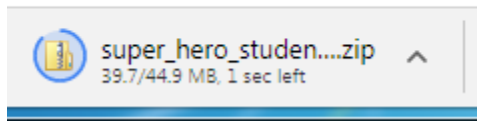
- Download the resources (click on the icon on the webpage)



## f) Student Resources

- Unzip the folder and put it in your Documents folder
  - Double-click on the zip file
  - When it opens, drag the folder and drop it in your Documents folder.
  - If you don't unzip it, you won't be able to edit the contents.
  - You'll see 4 folders and a few other files, like picture 3 below:



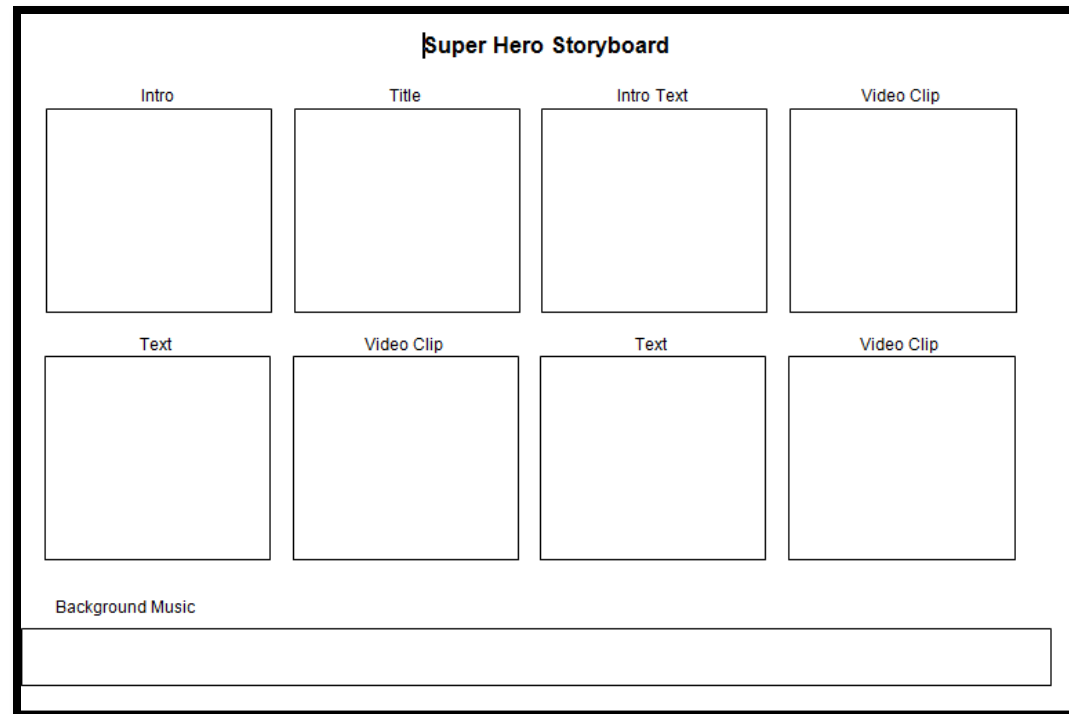
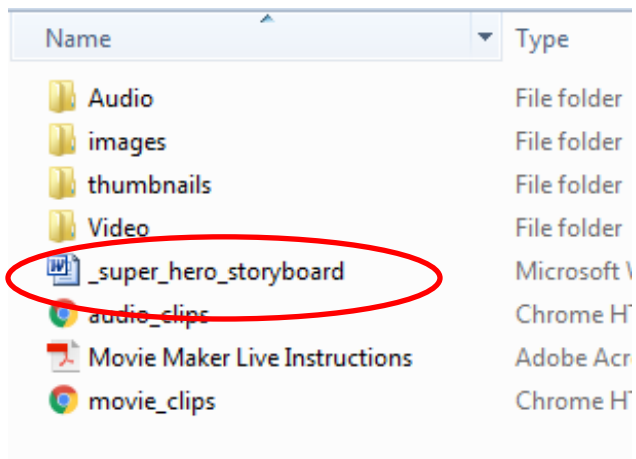

# Create the Storyboard: Open the Word Document

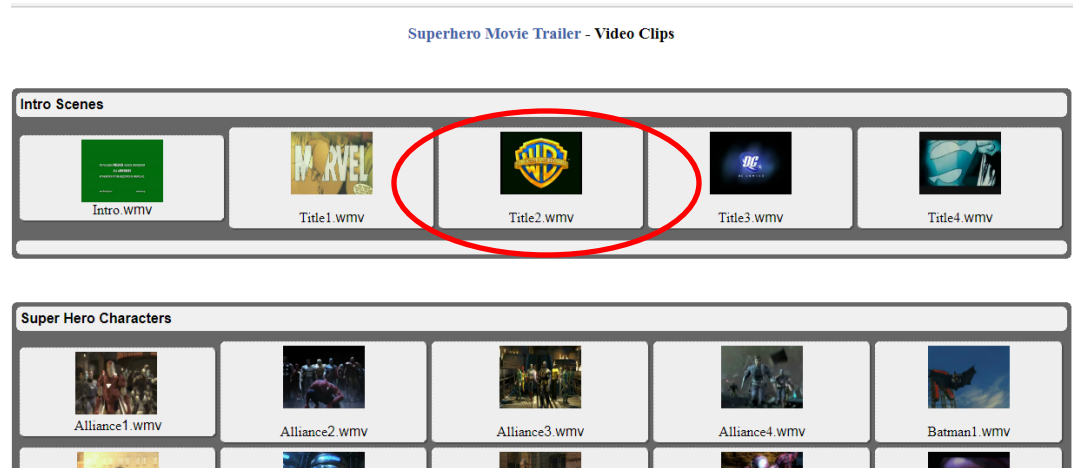
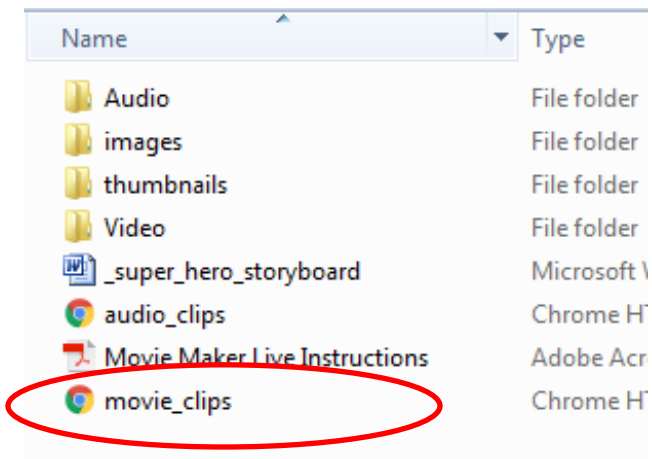
- Open **Super\_Hero\_Storyboard.docx** (circled, below)
- The document looks like the graphic on the bottom right.





# Create the Storyboard: View the movie clips

- Open **movie\_clips.html** (circled, below)
  - The file looks like the graphic on the bottom right.
- To view the clips, click on the thumbnail (one is circled for you).





# Create the Storyboard: Add the thumbnail to your storyboard

- Watch several of the clips.
- Choose which clips you want to include in your trailer
- You'll need an intro scene and a few others.
- Take a screen capture of the clips that you want to use and paste them in the correct order in your storyboard.
- Make sure that you can see the clip's title.
- You'll also need text and music (audio clips, circled below)



# Create the Trailer

- Open Movie Maker 
- Have your storyboard open as you work in Movie Maker.
- Create your trailer from your selection of short clips which matches your storyboard, uses consistent text and transitions and includes an appropriate background track.
